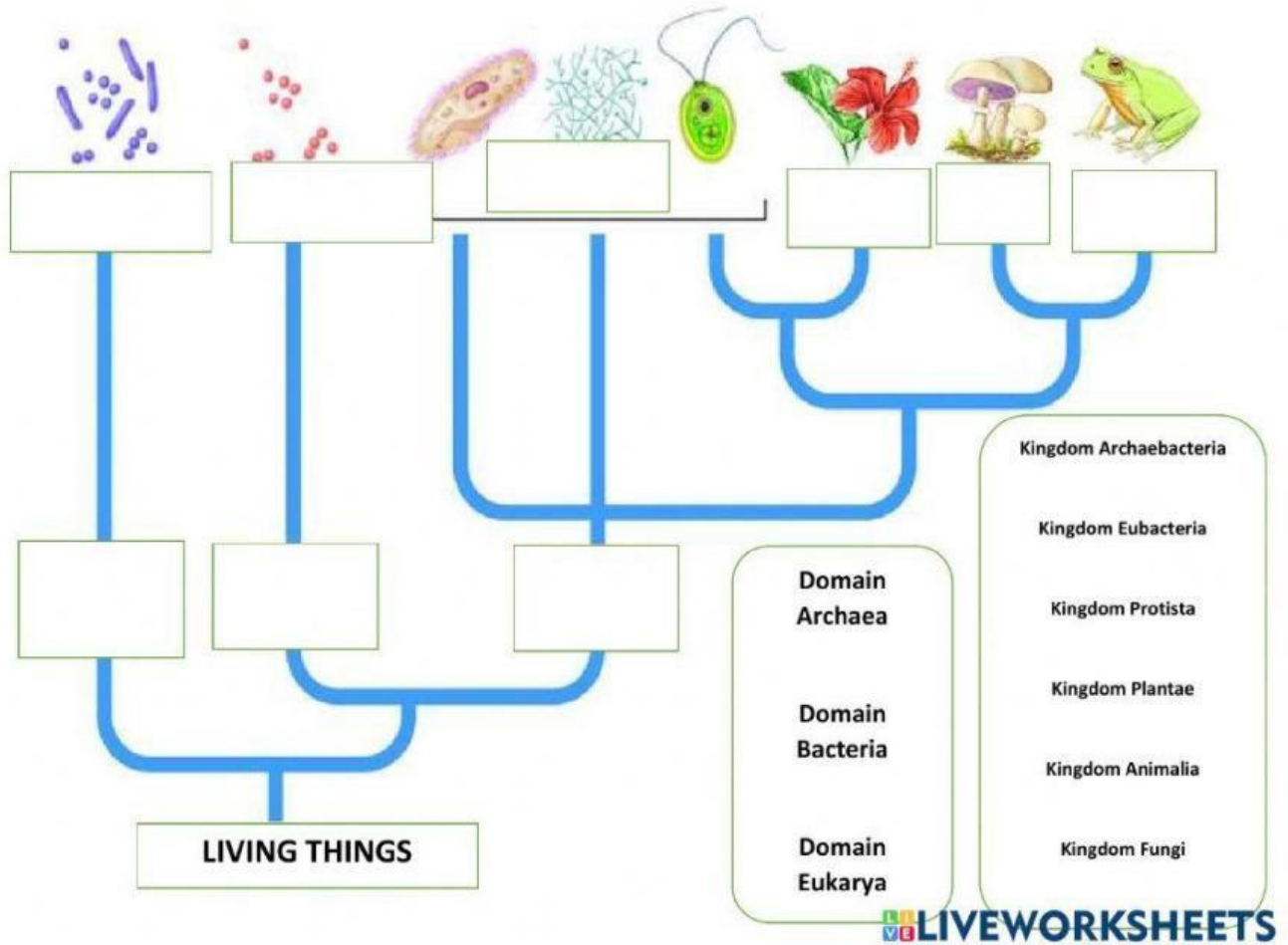


PRACTICE: SIX KINGDOMS OF LIFE – Drag and drop the appropriate boxes to arrange them from the most simple to the most complex (left to right).
