Regular Short Adjectives

Common	→	fast	the fastest
Ends with e	→	nice	the nicest
Ends with consonant + y	→	easy	the easiest
Ends with consonant + vowel + consonant	→	thin	the thinnest

Regular Long Adjectives

beautiful	the most beautiful
difficult	the most difficult
expensive	the most expensive

Irregular Adjectives

good	the best
bad	the worst
far	the farthest/furthest
