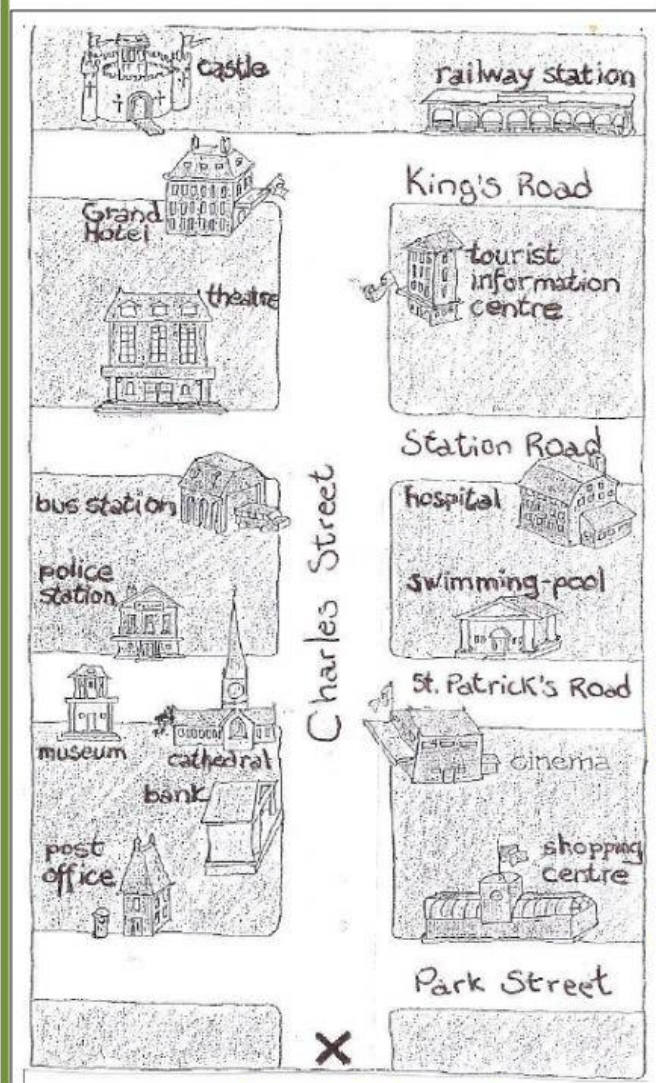


Giving directions
