

A. Compute $\int (x^2 + 5)^3 2x \, dx$.

Solution:

(1). let $u = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$$du = 2x \, dx$$

$$\int (x^2 + 5)^3 = \int u^3 \, du$$

$$= \frac{u^4}{4} + C$$

B. Compute $\int 6x^2 \sqrt{2x^3 + 5} \, dx$

let $u = 2x^3 + 5$

(3). $du = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$$\int \sqrt{2x^3 + 5} \, 6x^2 \, dx = \int \sqrt{u} \, du$$

(4). $= \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$$= \frac{u^{\frac{3}{2}}}{\frac{3}{2}} + C$$

$$= \frac{2}{3} u^{\frac{3}{2}} + C$$
