The Beginning

In July of 2017, the online game Fortnite was released. The goal of this popular video game is to be the last person standing in a live-action showdown. One hundred players battle each other alone, with a partner, or in a squad of three to four people. Fortnite can be played on many different systems such as Mac, Windows, Playstation4, and Xbox. Since it is so easily accessible, and is free for anyone who has access to these systems, it has become one of the most successful video games played today. It is played by more than 125 million people worldwide!

The Game

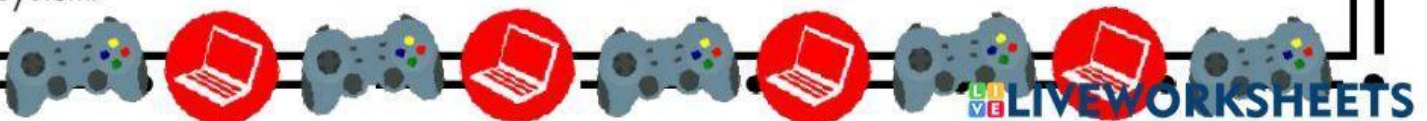
The game begins as players are dropped from a "Battle Bus," a large, blue school bus that flies high in the air with the help of a hot air balloon. Players are dropped at high speed and are able to steer themselves to land at the most optimum, or best, place on the map.

By using certain controls, players are able to launch a hang glider, which slows the flight of their character. This allows for more time to search the map for a place to land. It is always a good idea to land among building and structures, as there are more materials to collect there!

Players are able to use a pickaxe to knock down structures and collect materials such as brick, metal, and wood. They can use these items to quickly travel throughout the map, protect themselves, or to hide from other players!

The Winner

The winner of the game is the last player standing. There are safe zones within the game; however during each round, a storm comes and the safe zone shrinks in size. Players that are not in this area receive damage during the storm. This means that there is an even smaller playing area, which makes it easier to eliminate others, or be eliminated yourself! Fortnite is a fun and addicting game, and the best part about it is that it is free to anyone that has access to a gaming system!
