Food is chewed in the mouth and mixed with saliva. We call this mixture bolus.

In the large intestine indigested food, what your body doesn't need, is mixed with water to be eliminated through you anus.

In the small intestine food is mixed with bile and digestive enzymes. It breaks down food into nutrients your body can absorb.

Muscles in the oesophagus push the bolus down into the stomach.

The stomach is like a mixer. It breaks food down into smaller pieces and mixes it with gastric juices.

Your gallbladder stores the bile produced by your liver.

Your liver produces a liquid called bile.

Your pancreas produces digestive enzymes.
