The Grand Bazaar in Istanbul, Turkey, is More Than 500 years old and it has More Than four Thousand Shops Under One Roof! You can buy Almost anything, but the most popular items Are The Beautiful Rugs and carpets. It's Open all day every day!

Many Belgians Say that the Grand Place - in the center of the capital city Is The most Beautiful Square in the world. It is the home of a colorful flower Market -Open every day except monday. On monday, instead of flowers, There's a wonderful bird Market.

One of the most unusual Markets is in Mexico City: at the Sonora Market. As well as toys and Birds, you can buy herbs and natural medicines Which (they say) can help with anything -from Problems at work to problems with your marriage! It's Open every day from early in the morning till late at night.

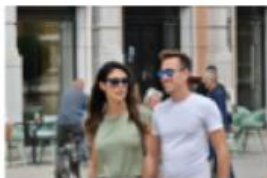
