

Indirect Object

The indirect object is the person or thing “for whom” the verb is being done.

Example:

Bob gave Steven a cookie.

In the above example “cookie” is the Direct Object while “Steven” is the Indirect Object.

The “cookie” is what is being given while “Steven” is who the cookie is for.
