**Should** and **shouldn't** are used for \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_

Example: You **should** eat healthy food



**Have to** is used for a \_\_\_\_\_

Example: You **have to** take the pills the doctor prescribed



**Don't have to** is used when there is no \_\_\_\_\_ to do something

Example: You **don't have to** go to the shop. Mom have already bought food
