Two years later, Anne _____ (give) birth to twins, Judith and Hamnet. Practically nothing _____ (know) about the following few years of his life. Later Shakespeare _____ (go) to London to work as an actor and a writer in the Globe Theatre. While he _____ (work) in London, his son Hamnet died. William _____ (return) home to Stratford a few years before his death in 1616.

Shakespeare's work _____ (be) still very popular nowadays, since almost every play _____ (contain) the complete range of human emotions and conflicts. If you go to London, you _____ (have) the opportunity to see one of his plays at the Globe theatre. Even today they still _____ (perform) them there. Last month you _____ (can) see Othello and this month they _____ (play) Romeo and Juliet.
