I am not = I'm not

You are not = You aren't **OR** You're not

|--------------------------|-------------------------------------|--------------------------|
| Am I in class 2?         | Yes, you are.                       | No, you aren't.          |
| Are you Mike?            | Yes, I am.                          | No, I'm not.             |
