This pizza is made 27 no toppings other than salt and oil and is served as a snack.

Preparation:

Preheat oven 28 500°F.

Whisk together hot water and 1/2 a teaspoon of kosher salt until most of the salt is dissolved, then whisk with one tablespoon of oil.

Coat the dough lightly 29 flour, then stretch it on a floured surface into a 13- by 9-inch rectangle. Transfer the dough 30 an oiled baking pan, stretching the dough to cover the bottom of the pan. Dimple the dough by pressing your fingertips all over, then brush with the oil mixture.

Bake the pizza in a pan on the bottom rack of the oven until it is golden brown on top and bottom, about 10 to 12 minutes. Transfer the pizza 31 a rack, then brush it with the remaining oil and sprinkle it with the remaining kosher salt. Serve the pizza warm, torn into pieces.
