During this period the Moon enters a series of phases, which change the amount of light reflected off its surface and its visible shape to the naked eye from the Earth. (5) _____ of the Moon began in 1959 when the unmanned Luna 2 landed on its surface. Luna 2 was slowly followed by Luna 3 in late 1959, which obtained the first images of the occluded far side of the moon, and the first people to land on the Moon (6) _____ aboard Apollo 11 on that historic night in 1969.
