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12. Alex will be fine if you stay with him. (AS LONG AS)

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13. If he doesn't insult her, your brother will be able to come to my sister's party. (PROVIDING THAT)

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14. If he doesn't stop screaming, Jenni will be very upset with him. (UNLESS)

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15. She will light a fire now if we need some illumination later on. (IN CASE)

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
