The Buildings of Egypt

A. The Bibliotheca Alexandrina

The Bibliotheca Alexandrina, in Alexandria, is one of the most interesting buildings in Egypt. It opened in 2001. It is a big circle, and one side is lower than the other. The building is a library, and it's very big: it has 11 floors and there is enough space for 8 million books! There are also four museums and four art galleries in the library.



B. The Cairo Tower

The Cairo Tower is on an island in the river Nile, near the centre of Cairo. It opened in 1961, and it's 187 metres high; it was the tallest building in Egypt until 1998. There are restaurants inside, and one of them moves around in a circle! There is also a great viewing floor, and you can look down at the city!

C. Manial Palace

Manial Palace is in the south of Cairo, and it is also on an island in the Nile. It is the most famous modern palace in Egypt. It has furniture from many different countries, such as Iran, Syria and Morocco, so it's one of the most interesting places to walk around. The gardens are similar, and you can find plants from England and Iran. A prince decided to build the palace and started in the year 1899. It opened thirty years later, in 1929.

D. Ramses Railway Station

Ramses Railway Station is the most important railway station in Cairo. It's a very beautiful building, with blue and gold glass on the walls and ceiling. For many years, there was a very old statue of pharaoh Ramses II outside. Now it's in the Grand Egyptian Museum. There are trains to cities all over Egypt, including Luxor and Alexandria.
