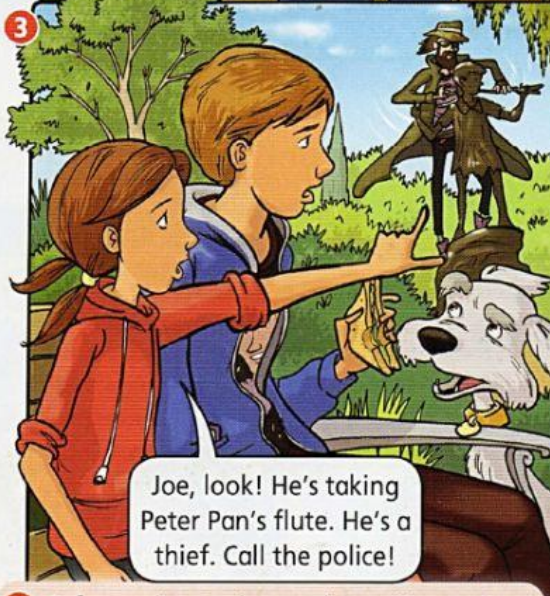
1 Becky and her brother, Joe, are in Kensington Gardens, a famous park in London.

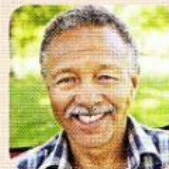

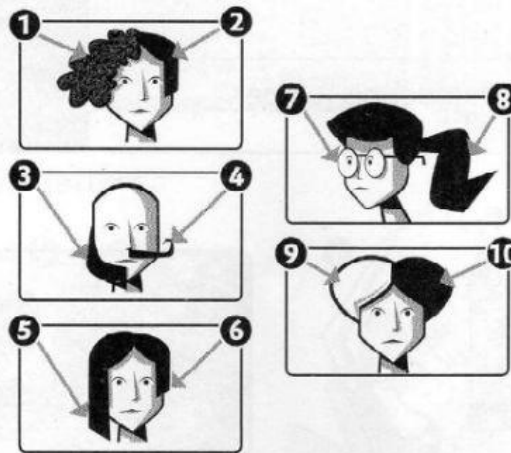

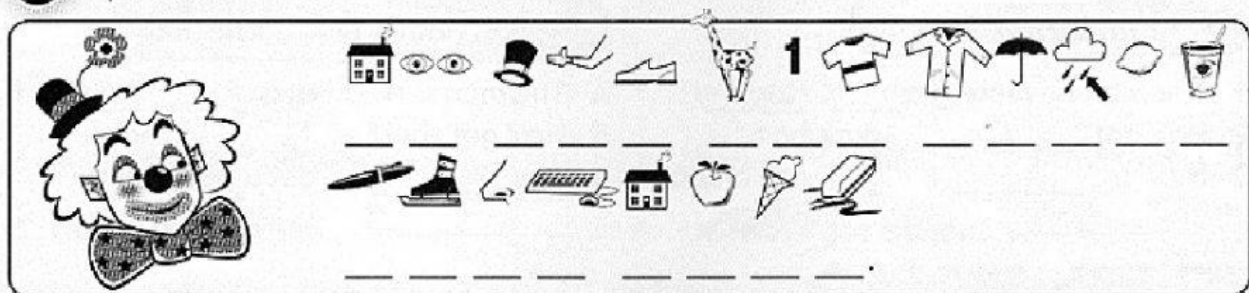
