Used to: My father **used to** live in Paris.

- For actions and states
- Used with stative verbs (NON ACTION VERBS)
 - Negative: didn't use to...
 - Questions: Did (he) use to...?

Would: We **would** visit my grandmother every summer when I was little.

- For an event that happened many times
- Cannot be used with stative verbs (NON ACTION VERBS)
- No negative or question
