STRING FAMILY


- METAL, SKIN, WOOD...

- HITTING, SCRAPING OR SHAKING THE INSTRUMENT

PERCUSSION FAMILY

- MOST OF WOOD, BUT THERE ARE SOME MADE OF METAL

- USING A BOW OR PLUCKING STRINGS WITH THE FINGERS



- WOOD

- PRESSING KEYS, WHICH MOVE LITTLE HAMMERS THAT HITS SOME MATERIAL.

- DIFFERENT MATERIALS

- VIBRATING THE LIPS WHILE BLOWING AND PRESSING KEYS OR SLIDING A PART OF THE INSTRUMENT

KEYBOARD INSTRUMENTS

- METAL

- BLOWING AIR AND OPENING OR CLOSING THE HOLES/KEYS WITH FINGERS

- PRESSING KEYS, WHICH ALLOWS THE AIR TO ENTER INTO THE INSTRUMENT.
