

**The Olympics**

The first modern Olympics were in Athens, in 1896, but there are many differences between the early days of the games and the Olympics today. In the first games there were 245 sportsmen from only 14 countries, and there were only nine different sports. Nowadays the whole world participates and there are approximately 17,000 competitors from 205 countries—that is a big change! Another big social change is in the number of women involved. In 1896 there were no women at all. Today there are sportswomen in all 26 Olympic sports, but men still win more medals because there are still 38 more events for men.

**The World Cup**

The first World Cup was in 1930 in Uruguay. There were only 13 teams and all of the games were in Montevideo. In the final, Uruguay beat Argentina 4-2. These days, over 200 teams try to enter the competition, but only 32 teams get through to the finals. There are other differences too. Until 1970 there were no red or yellow cards. Nowadays teams that don't get many cards can win the Fairplay award and there are other awards too. In 1930 there were only the winner's cup and the Golden Ball for the best player. Today there is also the Golden Boot for the top goal-scorer and the top goalkeeper can win the Golden Glove.
