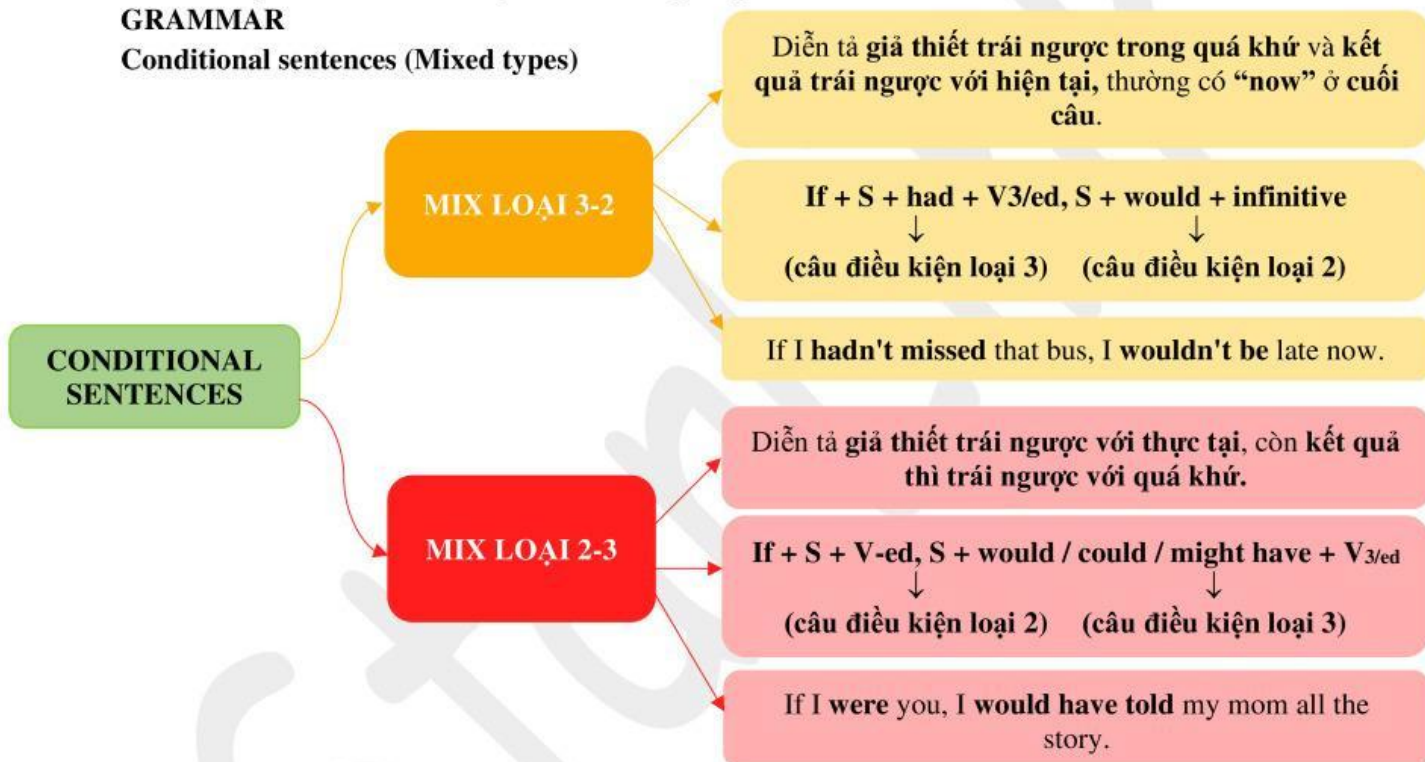

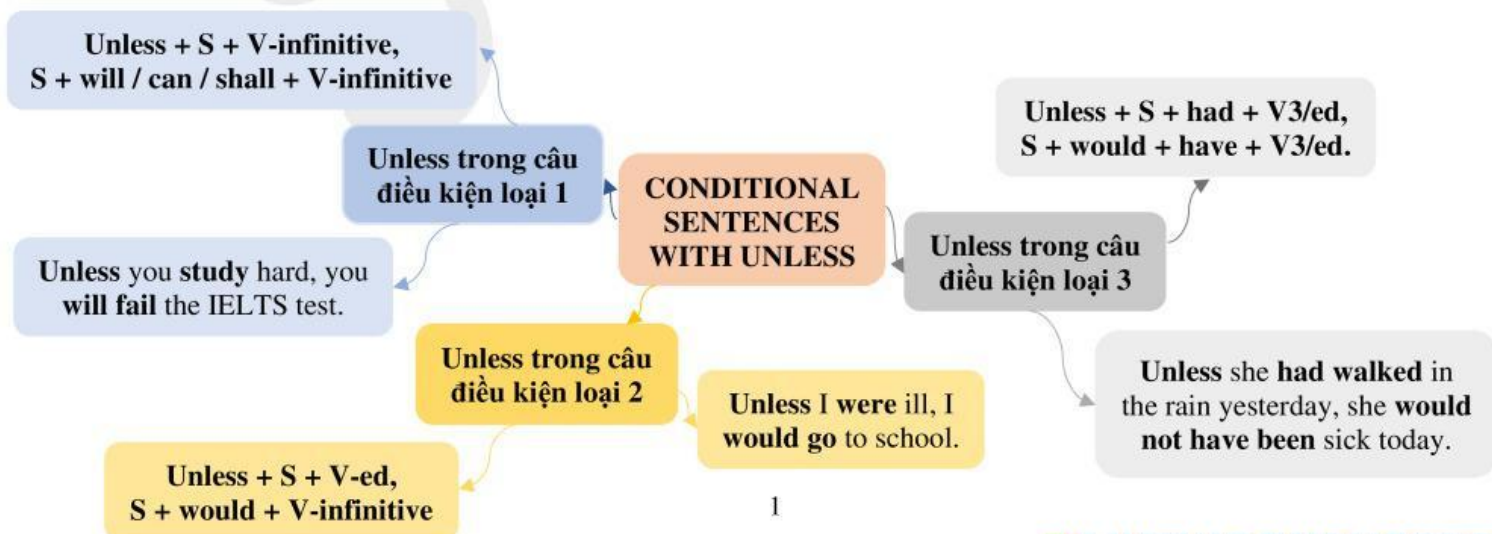

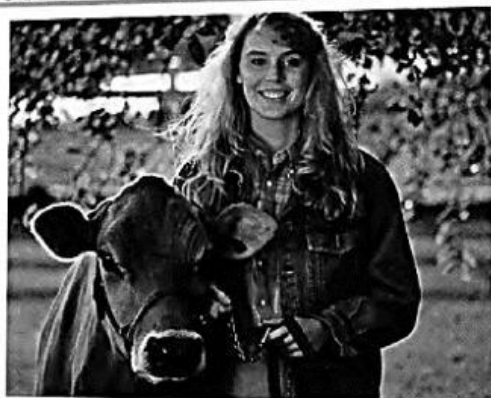

AVA AUSTRALIA



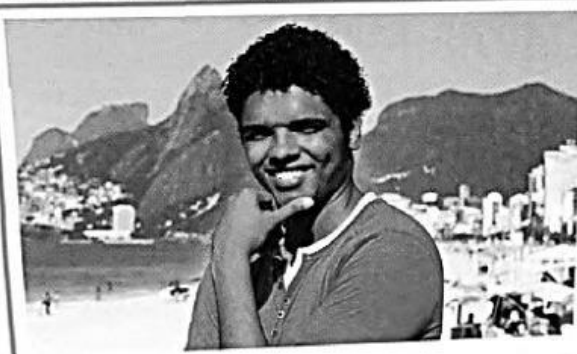
