

Soil moisture

held within an aquifer accounts for approximately 0.65% of all water on Earth.

Ground water

contain approximately 97.2% and cover the majority of the Earth.

Glaciers

hold only 0.009% of all water.

Fresh water and saline water lakes

are the second-largest store of waterhold about 2.1% of the world water.

Oceans

just 0.001 per cent as vapor but essential for biodiversity and robust ecosystems.

Streams, wetlands, and swamps

accounts for only 0.005% of worldwide water distribution.
