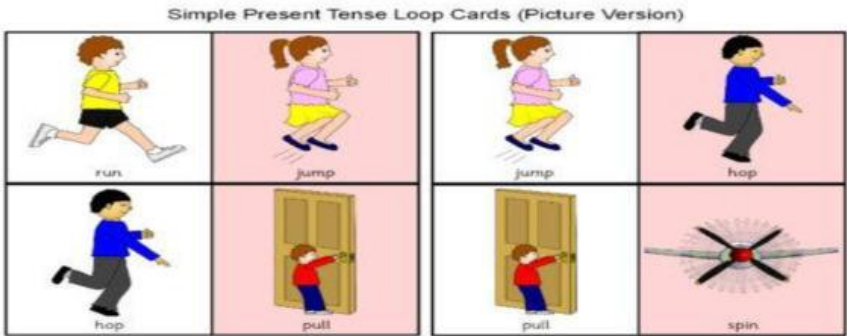

## Forms

- +** S + V(s/es) + O.
- S + don't/doesn't + V (base form) + O.
- ?** Do/does + S + V(base form) + O ?
