Scared /seɪ.kɪd/ – กลัว: ลงท้ายด้วย /r/ แต่ ed จะออกเสียงเป็น /ɪd/

Blessed /bles.ɪd/ – อวยพร: ลงท้ายด้วย /s/ แต่ ed จะออกเสียงเป็น /ɪd/

Crabbed / /kræbd/ – วิจารณ์ อ่านว่า /d/ ถ้าเป็นกริยา แต่ ed จะออกเสียงว่า “ɪd” ถ้าใช้ crabbed เป็นคำคุณศัพท์

/kræb.ɪd/ – ความล้อเล่น แทะก๊ัก
