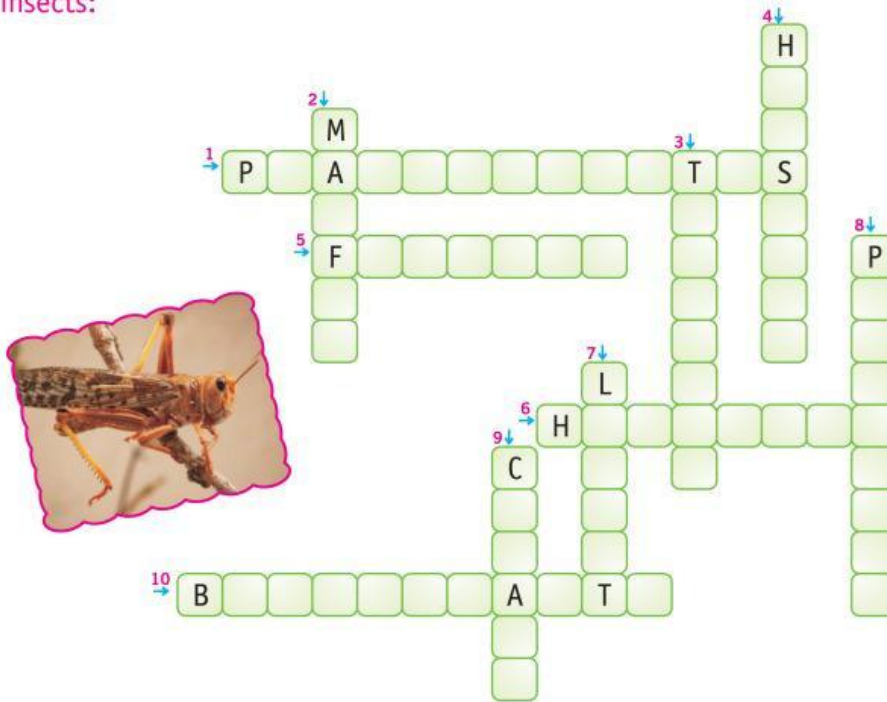


22 Insect's Quiz
