

Review the examples of classroom activities provided below.
Determine which learning style each activity most effectively supports.

Rhymes & Songs

Use English songs and rhymes to teach vocabulary and pronunciation. Students sing along.

Picture stories

Show a series of pictures that tell a story. Have students describe what is happening in each picture or put the pictures in the correct order.

Pictionary

Have students draw pictures related to new vocabulary seen and others have to guess the meaning.

Simon Says

Use this classic game to teach action verbs, body parts, and commands. For example, "Simon says touch your nose" or "Simon says jump."

Charades

Have students act out vocabulary words or phrases without speaking while others guess the word or phrase.

Word hunt

Hide flashcards with vocabulary words. Students move around to find the cards and then use the words in sentences.

Audio game

Play audio recordings of conversations, stories, or songs and ask students to answer questions or summarize what they heard.
