Present Simple: Subject-Verb Agreement

These verbs show action, so they are called **action verbs**.

eat	drink	walk	run	swim	play
look	sleep	read	write	sing	dance

The **subject** and the **verb** must agree with each other in a sentence.
We add **-s** to the verb when the subject is **he, she, or it**.
