## QUANTIFIERS: SOME/ANY

| STATEMENT                                            | NEGATIVE                         | QUESTION                        |
|------------------------------------------------------|----------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| <b>Plural Nouns</b><br>I have <b>some</b> cookies.   | I don't have <b>any</b> cookies. | Do you have <b>any</b> cookies? |
| <b>Uncountable Nouns</b><br>I need <b>some</b> water | I don't need <b>any</b> water.   | Do you need <b>any</b> water?   |



**NOTE 1:** With questions in which we expect the answer to be 'Yes', we can use 'some' instead of 'any'. Example: "Could you please give me some bananas?"

**NOTE 2:** Some common **uncountable nouns** include: **coffee, food, help, homework, information, milk, money, paper, rice, salt, soup, sugar, tea, time, water.**

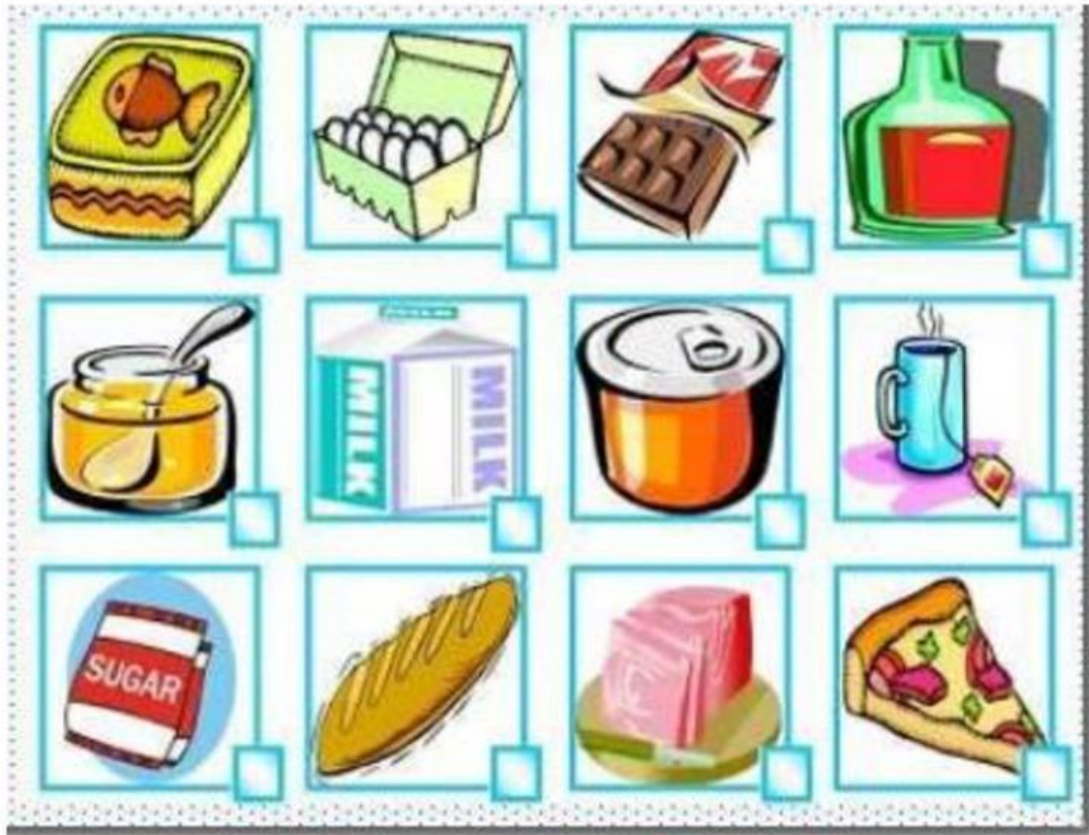

**A/AN**



**A/AN** is used before countable nouns in the singular.

- I have got a blue car.
- There is a book on the table.

Also, we use **A/AN**, when we use an expression of quantity that make the uncountable noun countable. Some of these expressions are:

*A bunch, a piece, a jar, a bottle, a tube, a bar, a glass, a dozen, a kilo, a can, a tin ...*

- There is a piece of bread here.
- I have got a bar of chocolate.

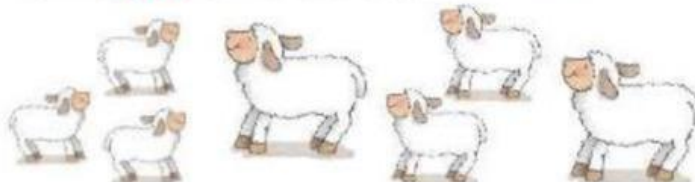
