

How to Register for a Covid-19 Test – Students

Before you start, please write your name on the registration card.

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Register your barcode online

Either scan the QR code or go to gov.uk/enter-lateral-flow-test

If you need any help, please ask a member of staff.

Step 1: Take a registration form and scan the QR Code on the registration form. If you can't scan then please follow link on registration page

Register a coronavirus test

Use this service to register a coronavirus test for you or someone else.

You need to register each coronavirus test to get the results.

To complete this form, you'll need:

- the test kit barcode for the test you're registering
- a mobile number (for you or the person you're registering it for)
- the Royal Mail barcode on the return box (only if you're registering a home test kit)

If you're taking a test before your hospital visit, you need to [register your kit here](#).

Step 4: Click on continue without account

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Enter the unique test kit barcode

If you have a home test kit, use the camera on your phone or computer to scan one of the identical barcodes on the plastic tube, plastic bag and return box.

Or you can manually enter the 11 character reference below the barcode.

If you're using a home test kit, you'll find the identical barcodes inside the home test kit, either attached to the plastic vial, biohazard bag and return box or loose for you to stick on yourself (please read instructions).

These are different from your pre-paid Royal Mail return package barcode on your box.

Step 5: You can either scan the barcode on your registration form by clicking on the 'scan barcode' button or you can enter it manually.

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What's the test site's ID?

The test site ID will be either 3 or 4 characters.

If you're isolating after international travel, the test site is your government isolation hotel.

If you're still at the site and cannot find the test site ID, ask a member of staff.

If you're registering after leaving the site, staff should have told you to take a photo or write down the test site ID.

Step 7: Once you enter have entered the test site ID, you confirm the test site as WFC

This will help us track and trace the spread of coronavirus.
