Question 1. In the following magic squares, the product of each row (or each column) is always the same. Complete the magic squares.

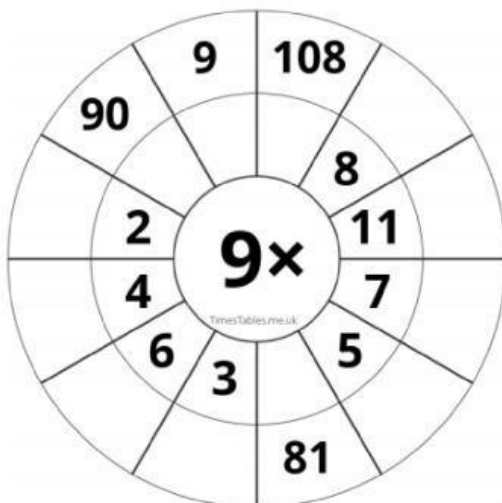
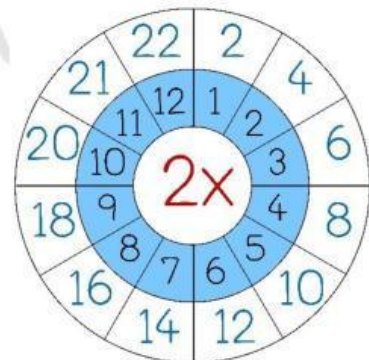
