Present Continuous

Affirmative sentences: Subject + verb to be (am,is, are) + wearing + complement.

I am wearing a cap.

We are wearing t-shirts.

She is wearing socks.

They are wearing pants.

Negative sentences: Subject + verb to be (am,is, are) + not + verb (ing) + complement.

I am not wearing a skirt.

She is not wearing a hat.

She isn't wearing sneakers.

**Podemos utilizar la contracción del verbo to be + not (isn't / aren't)
