Present Continuous

Affirmative sentences: Subject + verb to be (am,is, are) + verb (ing) + complement.

I am reading a book.

He is playing soccer.

She is talking with a friend.

They are watching with a friend.

Negative sentences: Subject + verb to be (am,is, are) + not + verb (ing) + complement.

I am not reading a book.

She is not talking with a friend.

She isn't talking with a friend.
