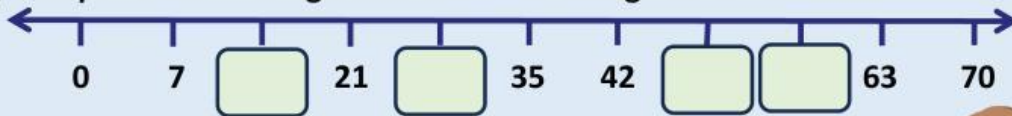


Measurements (length) & Representation Of Numbers On A Number line
