

Read the following passage about the daily life of a philosopher.

For 27 years the philosopher Arthur Schopenhauer followed an **identical** routine. He rose every morning at seven and had a bath but no breakfast; he drank a cup of strong coffee before sitting down at his desk and writing until noon. At noon he **ceased** work for the day and spent half an hour practicing the flute, on which he became quite a skilled performer. Then he went out for lunch at his favorite restaurant. After lunch he returned home and read until four when he left for his daily walk; he walked for two hours no matter what the weather. At six o'clock he visited the reading room of the library and read *The Times*. In the evening he attended the theatre or a concert, after which he had dinner at a hotel or restaurant. He got back home between nine and ten and went early to bed. He was willing to **deviate from** this routine in order to receive visitors.
