Sunny Days:

On sunny days, the sky is clear, and the sun is bright. It is warm outside. Kids play in the park, fly kites, and eat ice cream under the blazing sun.

Hot Summer:

When it is very hot, there might be a heatwave. The sun is strong, and it feels dry and scorching. Kids go to the pool to cool down. They have water balloon fights and eat ice cream to escape the heat.

On humid days, the air feels wet and sticky. Even if it is warm, the air feels heavy. Kids play in the shade or inside where it is cooler.
