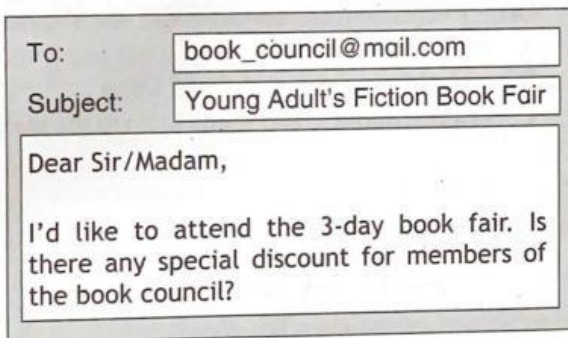

The Space and Science Centre

The Space and Science Centre is a good place to widen your knowledge about space and exploration. There are many interesting exhibitions half of which are interactive. There are some interesting spots to visit there such as planetarium and observatory room. The centre also offers themed activities for students such as experimenting with colours and exploring dinosaurs.

Before you go to the centre, download its map and find out about the documentary showtime screened at the planetarium. The centre recommends the public to purchase tickets in advance especially at the weekends, special events and public holidays.

The centre is open from Tuesday to Sunday, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. On public holidays, the centre stays open until 6 p.m. The Observatory is open on Friday and Saturday evening from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. for telescope viewing. This activity depends on the weather, so call the centre first.

The Space and Science Centre offers a variety of facilities. The parking lot is at the main entrance of the centre. There is also a multistorey lot at the observatory complex. Wheelchairs are available at the reception desk. It is best to call ahead to reserve a wheelchair because supply is limited. There is also wheelchair seating at the planetarium.

The centre offers a membership programme too. A lifetime membership is RM150 and these members can enter the centre and watch the shows for free. An entry ticket for adults is RM18 and for children aged 5 to 12 years old is RM5. Senior citizens and students aged 13 to 18 only pay RM8.

Exploring Kinabatangan River

Kinabatangan River is in the Sandakan Division in Sabah. At 560 km long, it is the second longest river in Malaysia.

The river is known for its rich biodiversity. There are limestone caves, riverine forest, freshwater swamp forest, oxbow lakes and salty mangrove swamps along the river. (33)

Visitors can see different types of wildlife. (34) They may also see proboscis monkeys or orangutans swinging from tree branches.

There are saltwater crocodiles in the river too. Sometimes, you cannot immediately see them. Observe the water closely – their eyes are just above the surface of the water. (35) Visitors are allowed to get into the water in these parts.

Visitors can visit the mangroves and caves in the area too. One of the most fascinating sights is watching millions of bats fly out of the caves at dusk. (36) These hawks wait to catch the bats as they fly out of the caves.

Beginners' Guide to Skateboarding

The first thing to do if you want to learn how to skateboard, is to focus on balance. It is very important in skateboarding.

First, place one foot on the front of the board. Which foot you put first depends on what you are comfortable with. (37) The distance between both feet should be as wide as your shoulders. Bend your knees a little too.

Once you are comfortable, it is time to move. (38) Then, put your foot back on the board. Keep your knees bent and your weight on the balls of your feet.

While moving, do not rock your body. (39) Do not make sudden movements either. Do not put your weight on the front or back of the board because the board can either pop up or slip from underneath you.

Finally, it is time to learn how to stop. When you are learning, you are moving slow. (40) Then, drag it on the ground to stop.

- E Therefore, just put your back foot on the ground.
- F Even a slight movement can affect your balance.
- G Use your back foot to push off.
- H Next, put the other foot of the board.
