Grammar

Present Simple for future meaning

We can use the **Present Simple** to mention an event with a fixed schedule, timetable or a known future fact.

Be on time! The movie begins at 7:45 p.m.

(a schedule)

The last bus leaves at 9:00 p.m. (a timetable)

Her birthday is on Saturday next week.

(a known future fact)

Prepositions of time

We can use **prepositions of times** to talk about when we will do something.

We can use **from... to...** to say how long something lasts.

Ann has Math class **from** 9 **to** 10 a.m.

We can use **until** to say up to the time mentioned.

Tom has soccer club **until** 6 p.m.

BUT science /'saɪəns/

♦ Stress in two and three-syllable nouns



• Most nouns with two or three syllables are usually stressed on the first syllable.

• handball /'hændbɔ:l/ • practice /'præktɪs/ • shuttlecock /'ʃʌtlkɑ:k/

BUT • machine /mə'ʃi:n/ • mistake /mɪ'steɪk/

• For three-syllable nouns ending in some suffixes as **-tion, -sion, -ic, -al**, the stress is on the syllable before these suffixes.

• collection /kə'lekʃn/ • decision /dɪ'sɪʒən/ • pandemic /pæn'demɪk/ • proposal /prə'pəʊzəl/

BUT • engineer /ˌendʒɪ'nɪr/ • referee /ˌrefə'ri:/

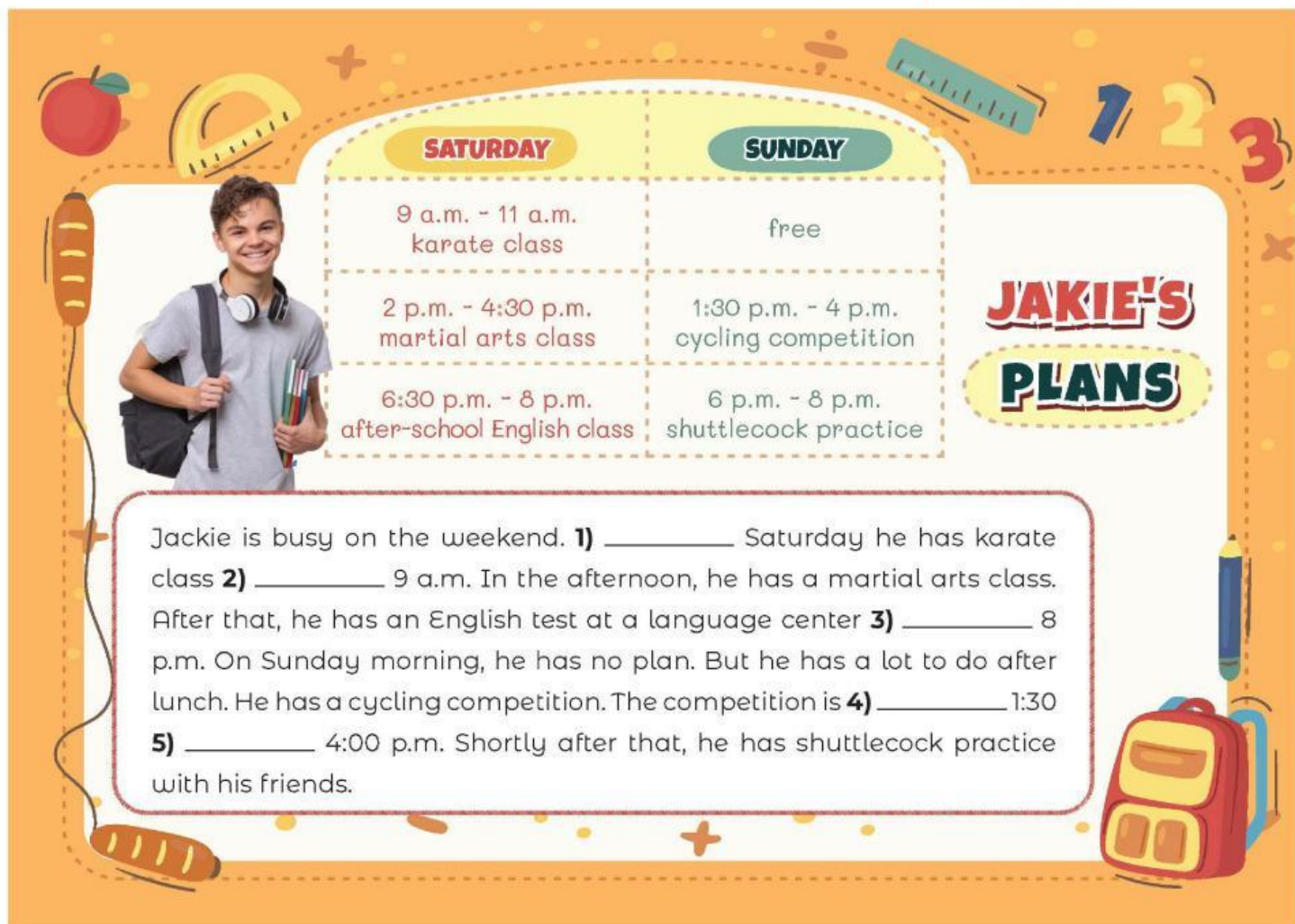
