

A. GRAMMAR

First conditional sentence with IF/ UNLESS (Câu điều kiện loại 1 với IF/ UNLESS)

1. Câu điều kiện loại 1: được sử dụng để diễn tả một sự việc, hiện tượng có khả năng xảy ra trong hiện tại hoặc tương lai.

2. Câu điều kiện loại 1 với IF:



***Note:** Hai mệnh đề trong câu điều kiện có thể đổi chỗ cho nhau được; nếu mệnh đề chính đứng trước thì giữa hai mệnh đề không cần dấu phẩy, ngược lại thì phải có dấu phẩy ở giữa.

Ex: If it rains, I will stay at home. (Nếu trời mưa, thì tôi sẽ ở nhà.)

We will miss our flight if we don't hurry up. (Chúng ta sẽ muộn chuyến bay nếu chúng ta không nhanh lên.)

3. Câu điều kiện loại 1 với UNLESS:

Cấu trúc **UNLESS** tương đương với **IF NOT**, vì vậy trong câu điều kiện, 2 từ này có thể thay thế cho nhau. Mặc dù **UNLESS** mang nghĩa phủ định nhưng nó lại được sử dụng trong câu khẳng định.

Ex: If John isn't tired, we will go out. (Nếu John không mệt, thì chúng tôi sẽ ra ngoài.)

➤ Unless John is tired, we will go out. (Trừ khi John mệt, chúng tôi sẽ ra ngoài.)
