

Adverbs of manner

We use adverbs to describe verbs. They tell us how something happens.

We usually add **-ly** or **-ily** to an adjective to form an adverb.



Simon has a beautiful voice.
He sings **beautifully**.

Amy is a healthy girl.
She always eats **healthily**.

adverb

Sometimes we do not add **-ly**:

She studies **hard**. ~~hardly~~
He behaves **well**. ~~goodly~~
