Working Conditions

Working conditions are regulated in Costa Rica by the Labor Code (Código de Trabajo), and by administrative directives issued through the Ministry of Labor. Among the basic stipulations in effect: minimum salary, a maximum workday with overtime stipulations, minimum safety and health requirements at the workplace, paid vacations and resting days, severance pay, mandatory Christmas bonus and maternity leave. Wage statistics published by the Inter-American Development Bank show that, although real minimum wages in Costa Rica fell by 1.4% between 1990 and 1992, they rose by 15% between 1992 and 1998.
