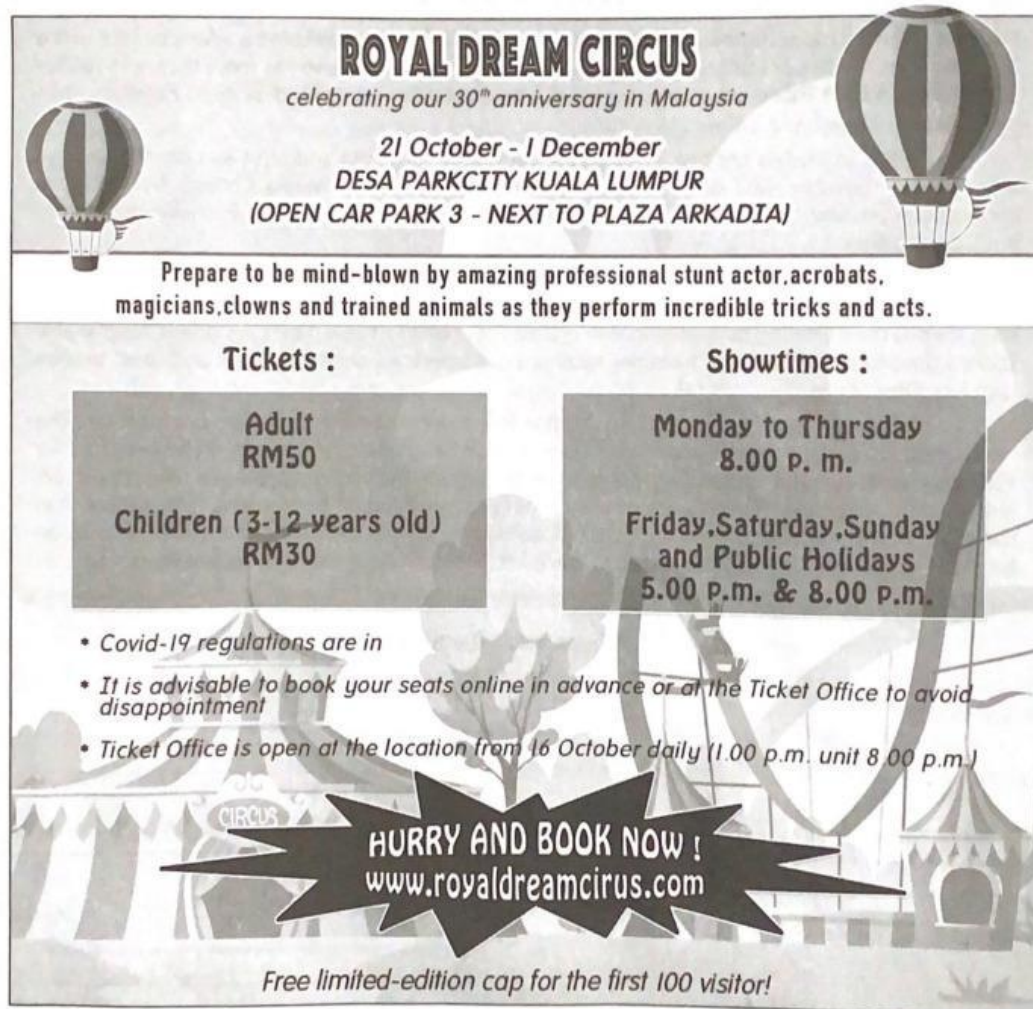

Geckos are reptiles with unique characteristics. They have short stout bodies, big heads, tails, and soft skins and are usually small in size. (33) _____ Most of them do not have moveable eyelids so they keep their eyelids clean by licking them with their tongues.

Besides that, geckos' tails have special features that help them to balance their weight and store fat. The tail also helps this creature to camouflage itself. (34) _____ Apart from that, geckos have clear protective layers covering the eyes. Their feet are interesting as the pads of their long toes are covered with small plates that are in turn covered with numerous tiny hair-like processes that are forked at the end. This enables geckos to climb across smooth and vertical surfaces like walls and ceilings. Some even have retractable claws. Some researchers claim that geckos can run fast across the surface of a water body without sinking if they are threatened by predators.

These creatures are found in many habitats, usually in warm climates such as deserts and jungles. Geckos are omnivores as they mostly feed on fruits, insects and worms. (35) _____

The gecko is one of the few reptiles that produce sound. (36) _____ Most geckos are nocturnal, which means they are active at night. This species is oviparous which means female geckos lay eggs. Usually, geckos will lay their eggs on leaves or beneath the bark of trees.

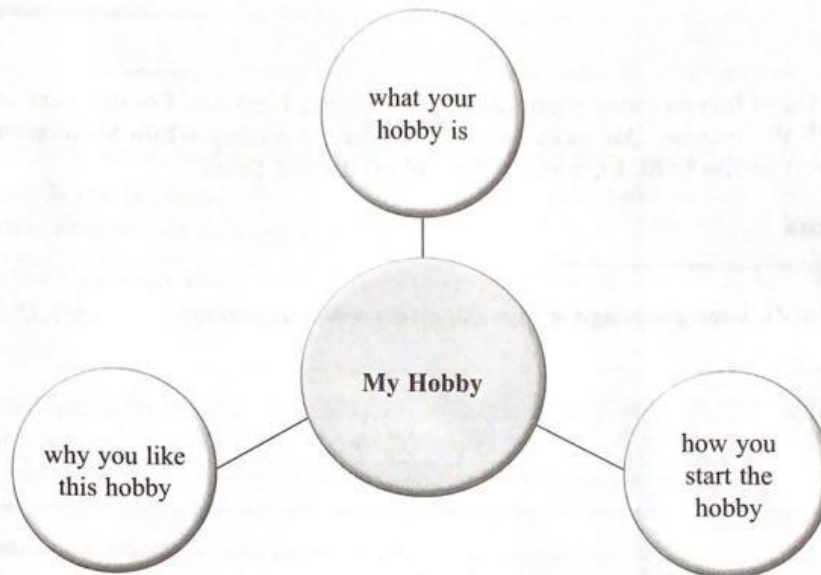
