The Second Conditional

We use the second conditional to talk about unreal situations and to imagine the results. The situation clause begins with **if** and has a past verb, not because the action is in the past, but because it is unreal. We can use **was** or **were** with **I, he, she** and **it**. The result clause has **could/would** + base verb. The two clauses can be used in any order.

Unreal Situation	Imaginary Result
If I (1)..... a thousand dollars,	(2)..... buy myself a huge TV.
If you (3)..... it all to charity,	you (4)..... have any left.
(5)..... you had a thousand dollars,	what (6)..... you do?
