1. Adverbs with 1 syllable: **adverb + er**
**Example:** faster, later, lower, etc.

(Jim works *later than* before.)

2. Adverbs with  $\geq 2$  syllables: **more + adverb**
**Example:** more carefully, more happily,  
more often, etc.

(The cat ran *more quickly* than the mouse.)

## 3. Irregular adverbs

| Adverb | Comparative Adverb |
|--------|--------------------|
| badly  | worse              |
| well   | better             |
| early  | earlier            |
| far    | further/farther    |
| little | less               |
| hard   | harder             |

(Anna sings *better than* Mary.)
