Healthcare:

Military:

- _____: Reduce budget for military defense; Safeguard nuclear weapons worldwide; believe peace is achieved through worldwide relationship building with other nations.
- _____: The key to protecting America is maintaining a strong military with a comprehensive defense system; believe that strengthening the military will build a safer world and better guarantee for peace.

Gun Control:

- _____: Restrictions on gun control; oppose the right to carry concealed weapons in public places.
- _____: Limit restrictions on gun control; Strongly support the Second Amendment, the Right to Bear Arms as well as the right to carry concealed weapons in public places.

Marriage:

- _____: Strongly against Same-Sex marriage; support marriage between man and woman only
- _____: Most support Same-Sex marriage

Abortion:

- _____: Pro-Life (human rights of the child come before the woman's choice); support alternatives to abortion such as adoption.
- _____: Pro-Choice (allows women to make their own choice)

Immigration:

- _____: Strict Immigration Restrictions (support closed or tight borders and regulating the amount of immigrants moving to the United States)
