1 Read the story.

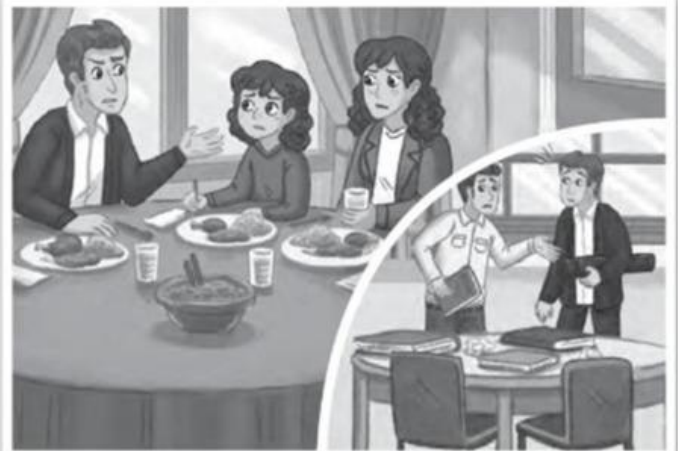
Time to Clean Up!
