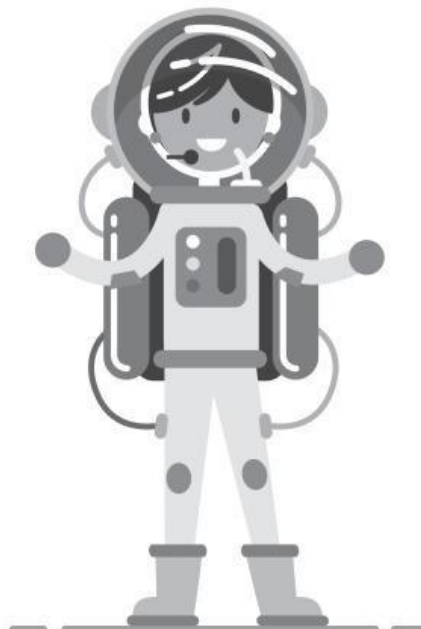

Speaking

Teaching notes

Award one point per item for accuracy and one point for ability to communicate well.

Activity 10 asks pupils to recycle the vocabulary and grammar points from Level 5 but also allows pupils to test their general knowledge of the English language.

Ask pupils to look at the list and form questions in their mind. They can also note some down. Allow them time to think of their own answers and, again, allow time for any note-taking. Put pupils in pairs or small groups of 3-4 pupils in order to discuss the questions. Monitor and check they are using question forms correctly, as well as answering the questions accurately. Each person should ask or answer five questions.

- 10 Read the prompts. Ask and answer with a partner or in a small group.

Example questions/answers: **A:** Are whales bigger than orangutans? **B:** Most whales are bigger than orangutans, but smaller whales are about the same size!

B: Was there a lake in your town when you were young? **A:** Yes, there was a lake and there were lots of trees. It was beautiful. **B:** Is there a lake now? **A:** Yes, there is, but there aren't any trees.

A: Did you feel afraid when you sang in the school musical? **B:** No, I didn't. I felt excited and very tired at the end!

B: Do you like animated films? **A:** Yes, I like some animated films. There's a Japanese director called Miyazaki – I like his films. How about you? **B:** No, I don't. I like to laugh, so I usually watch comedies.

A: What did you do on Monday? **B:** I didn't go to school because I was sick, so I sent an email to a friend and read my book.
