

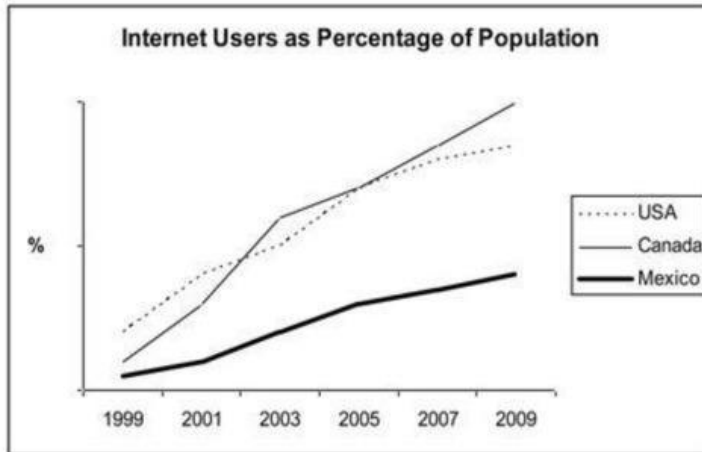
Practice Test 1

The figure shows the trends of Internet users as percentage of population in three countries.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features.

Model answer

Rearrange the following sentences to make a complete answer to the Practice Test above.

There are four paragraphs in total.

Overall, a much larger percentage of Canadians and Americans had access to the Internet in comparison with Mexicans, and Canada experienced the fastest growth in Internet usage.

By 2009, the percentage of Internet users was highest in Canada. Almost 100% of Canadians used the Internet, compared to about 80% of Americans and only 40% of Mexicans.

The line graph compares the percentage of people in three countries who used the Internet between 1999 and 2009.

In 1999, the proportion of people using the Internet in the USA was about 20%. The figures for Canada and Mexico were lower, at about 10% and 5% respectively.

It is clear that the proportion of the population who used the Internet increased in each country over the period shown.

In 2005, Internet usage in both the USA and Canada rose to around 70% of the population, while the figure for Mexico reached just over 25%.
