

17 Identity

An identity card is a card carrying the holder's photograph's, date of birth and other personal details, serving as official proof of their identity. In India, we have certain official identity cards. Here is their description. Read the description to fill in the blanks :

- 1 _____ is a 12 digit individual identification number issued by the unique Identification Authority of India on behalf of the Government of India. This number serves as a proof of identity and address anywhere in India.



- 2 _____ is unique to an individual or entity and it is valid across India. Once it is allotted to an individual or entity, it is unaffected by the change of name, address within or across states in India or any other factors.

- 3 _____ is an official document issued by the government, certifying the holder's identity and citizenship and entitling them to travel under its protection to and from foreign countries.



- 4 _____ is an identification card issued by the election commission to all eligible voters, to enable voter identification on Election Day.
