

A. Birds have some very distinct features. Write the names of these birds with the help of the given clues. Use the help card for your reference :



These birds are also called 'bottlenose' or 'sea parrot'. They are distinguished by their large, brightly coloured, triangular beaks. They can easily swim by using their wings to stroke underwater.



These large birds use their large elastic pouches to catch fish. They form a 'U' shaped formation to drive fishes into the shallow water, by beating their wings on the surface. When fish get to the shallows, they simply scoop them up.



These birds are found in American tropical forests. Their colourful and oversized beaks can be as long as one-third to reach fruits on branches that are too small to support their weight.



These birds are large, long-necked, tall and live in freshwater or wetlands. They have long legs, brightly coloured featherless heads, and prominent beaks.
