World Famous Monuments


Read the descriptions and write the names of the monuments :

It is the National Memorial of the USA, situated in South Dakota. The heads of four former Presidents of the USA- George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln are carved here.
