

21 Telling Time

Clocks, whether on the wall, on the computer screen or on our wrist in the form of watches, are all the standard forms of measuring the time. There are two basic types of clocks :

1. Analogue clocks :

(They have hands : hour hand, minute hand and second hand.)



2. Digital Clocks :

(They show time using digits; 0, 1, 2, 3, 9 only.)



It is very important for you to know how to read clocks. Let's find out how much you know about clocks.
